# Men's Service (Future Homes)

Supported, short-term accommodation for men experiencing, or at risk of, homelessness.

# What are Future Homes Services?

Located in East Perth, this service provides temporary short-term accommodation for up to three months while you are actively seeking to secure a long-term solution.

Throughout your tenancy with St Bart's you must engage with our case management process to help you explore suitable, long-term options.

Our male only accommodation offers single rooms with access to private or shared bathrooms, common cooking areas and a laundry.

You will have regular access to a case manager who will work with you to develop your individual recovery plan.

We also offer a range of support, referrals and other services that help you improve your personal health and wellbeing, with a view to reconnect you with friends and family where possible.

# Future Homes Support Services

We base our services on a recovery and trauma-informed practice. As your level of independence and confidence grows you become ready to move into long-term accommodation.



## SUPPORT

Access to regular meetings with a support team and chaplaincy service.



## ASSISTANCE

Explore long-term accommodation options and growing independent living skills.



## ADVOCACY

We provide advice and advocacy as well as access to external agencies.



## ACTIVITIES

Walking groups, meetings and competitions that aim to encourage social interaction.



## REFERRAL

Referral to appropriate health and community support agencies.

# Who is Eligible for Future Homes?

- Adult men aged 18+
- Currently residing in Western Australia.
- Experiencing or at risk of homelessness.
- Currently receiving, or entitled to, an income such as Centrelink or a regular wage.
- People who are willing to cooperate and proactively engage in an individual recovery plan.
- Willing to engage with the support program and work towards finding long-term accommodation.
- People who are willing to be respectful to staff, other consumers and St Bart's property.
- Willing and able to live in a shared environment.
