

Residential aged care service in East Perth



The James Watson Centre is a residential aged care centre where consumers can find a safe and supportive environment with access to a care plan centred on their preferences and needs.

Since 1963, St Bart's has continuously provided accommodation and care for men who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

In October 2012, the centre moved from Brown to Lime Street, East Perth, and increased in capacity to a specialised, government approved, 40bed residential and care provider.

Our central position in a prime inner city location, is in close proximity to essential medical services (including Royal Perth Hospital), as well as shops, public transport, libraries and community centres.

Services

Every room is provided with airconditioning, ensuite bathroom, adjustable bed, TV and an emergency call system to ensure safety.



CARE & SUPPORT

Access to regular care conferences and 24/7 care staff availability.



ACTIVITIES PROGRAM

Designed to provide opportunities for leisure, learning and socialiation.



PASTORAL CARE

An on- site chaplain is available and a Christian chapel service is offered.



MEALS

We work with consumers, dietitians and a catering service on the meals menu.

Who is Eligible?

Males who are over 65 years of age and currently experiencing or at risk of homelessness.

An Aged Care Client Record (ACCR) is completed by the Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT) referring the person for residential aged care, either on respite or as a permanent entry.
