Bart's Plus Family Service

Supported, short-term accommodation for families experiencing, or at risk of, homelessness.



What is our Family Service?

Located within the Perth metropolitan area, Bart's Plus is a low-level support service that provides short stay accommodation, while you are actively seeking to secure a long-term solution for you and your family.

Throughout your stay we will work alongside you to develop a support plan to help you explore suitable long-term accommodation options, as well as identify realistic and achievable goals that are appropriate to your family's needs.

We also offer a range of support, referrals and other services that help you achieve your goals.

Family Support Services

We base our services on a recovery and trauma-informed practice. As your level of independence and confidence grows you become ready to move into long-term accommodation.



SUPPORT

The Bart's Plus team will support you to work towards the goals you set for your family. Access to a Chaplaincy service is also available.



ASSISTANCE

Explore long-term accommodation options and growing independent living skills.



ADVOCACY

We provide advice and advocacy as well as access to external agencies.



COMMUNITY

Groups, meetings and other activities that encourage you to socialise and engage in the community.



REFERRAL

Referral to appropriate health and community support agencies

Who is Eligible?

- Parents/primary carers who are 18 years or over and whose youngest child is under 16 years and;
- Have custody of the child/ren at least 50% of the time.
- Are experiencing, or at risk of homelessness.
- Have the ability to manage their own accommodation with low level support.
- Have the means to pay accommodation fees based on the family income. (Families consisting of 2 parents/carers, must be willing to be registered with Centrelink as a couple).
- Are a permanent resident or citizen of Australia, currently residing in WA.
- Are willing to agree to the terms of our Licence to Occupy, Charter of Rights and Responsibilities and Accommodation Rules.
